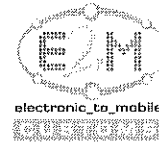


Subject : Implementation of Phase 4 of Customs e2m
